

What is Transitional Care Coordination?

- **Transitional Care Coordination** is an evidence-informed intervention that removes barriers and establishes relationships using **Warm Transitions**, a strategic approach that combines social work and public health tools and techniques.
- **Transitional Care Coordination** intervenes at individual, service and system levels using engagement strategies, right fit programs and community collaborations to improve outcomes for vulnerable populations.

What organizations benefit from Transitional Care Coordination?

- **Transitional Care Coordination** addresses community needs and benefits health and human services, university research and government programs.
- **Transitional Care Coordination** can benefit communities and enhance services at: alternatives to incarceration or sentencing programs, community health clinics, community corrections, correctional facilities, courts, diversion programs, employment services, health services, HIV/AIDS services, hospitals, homeless services, housing assistance, legal services, long term care, parole and probation, reentry programs, research universities, social services and substance use treatment.
